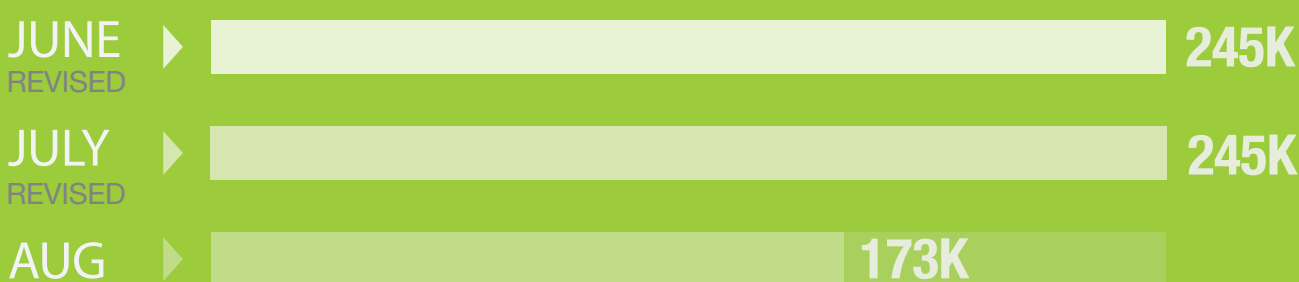

TOTAL NONFARM PAYROLL EMPLOYMENT¹

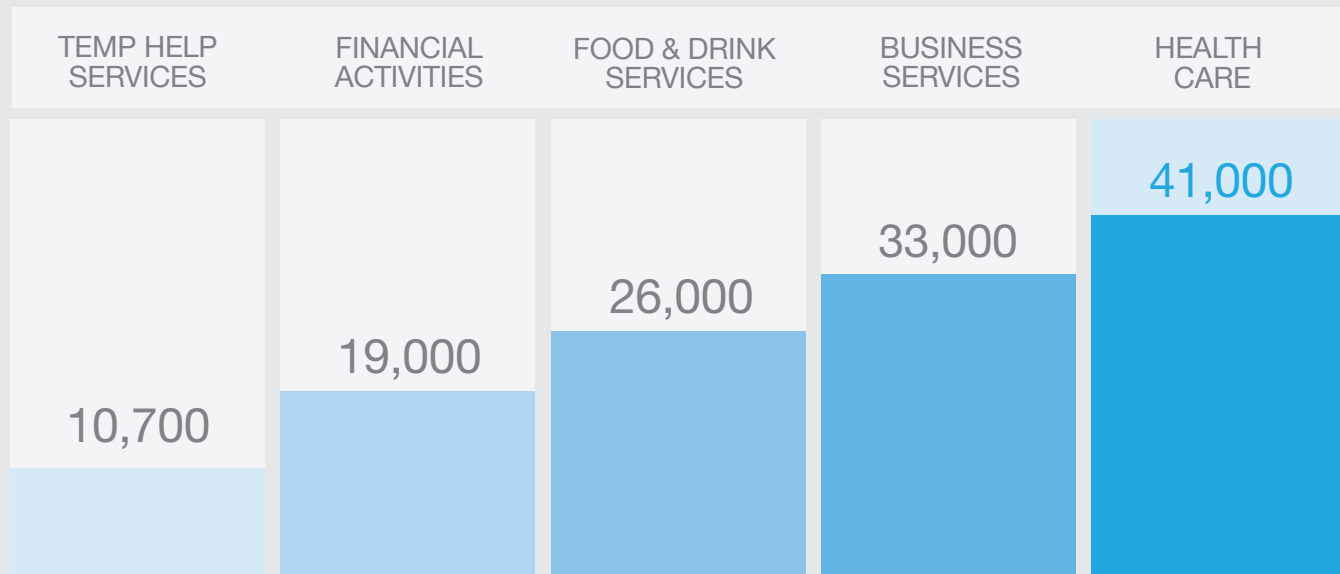
